- b. Any tree that appears unsafe must be reported to the secretary as soon as possible.
- c. A follow up discussion regarding possible transplanting of trees in the "tree farm" area of Russell Farms Community Park took place. Removing every other tree to allow the remaining trees to grow larger and thrive was discussed. Possible municipal locations for transplanted trees were suggested by members of the commission as well as by the Township Committee Liaison.
- d. A discussion occurred regarding right-of-way measurements and their interpretation.
