ORDINANCE #1968

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING SALARY ORDINANCE #1963 AND FIXING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN TOWN HALL EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. That the salaries and compensation of various paid officers and employees of the Township of Wyckoff shall be at the following rates:

Department/Position	Salary Range
Land Use Administrator	up to \$ 47,000

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed but only to the extent of said inconsistency. All other parts of Ordinance #1963 of the Township of Wyckoff not inconsistent herewith are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. The salaries recorded above shall be effective as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
