- 1. This Agreement shall be effective commencing on July 1, 2022 and continuing through December 31, 2025. Either party has the right to cancel as per signed agreement by providing ninety (90) day written notification.
- 2. Wyckoff shall provide to New Milford, licensed CFO, Diana McLeod, each week for 2 on site hours on the Monday preceding a New Milford public meeting as well as outside of regular business hours as per the signed agreement, for a fee.
- 3. In consideration for this service from Wyckoff's licensed CFO to the Borough of New Milford, New Milford shall pay to Wyckoff and annual fee as described in the Interlocal Service Agreement. This fee for services rendered shall be allocated in the Township of Wyckoff budget as a revenue item and budget appropriation for fee for services to both the Township and to the Wyckoff CFO for services performed.
- 4. All other services as describe in the Interlocal Service Agreement between the Township of Wyckoff and the Borough of New Milford.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and the Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the Inter-local Service Agreement and the CFO is authorized to begin implementing services as described in the agreement.

DECISION

Defendant is charged with violation of zoning ordinance Section 801 which prohibits the expansion of non-conforming uses. Under the ordinance, non-conforming uses may be continued however "no such non-conforming use or structure shall be enlarged, increased or charged, nor shall any non-conforming use be extended towoccupy a greater area of land or structure than that occupied by such use of structure at the date of the adoption of this ordinance."

The ordinance proscribes the enlargement or expansion of a non-conforming use or structure.

There is no dispute in this case that Defendant's operation of the "Barn" with off street parking on Block 436 Lot 4, is a non-conforming business use and structure in a residential zone.

The evidence is clear that on November 1970 Defendant arranged to have construction equipment remove soil, stones, shrubbery, remains of a foundation wall and other miscellaneous

items stored upon the property, from an area approximately 15 feat by 55 feat located to the rear of the "Barn" structure, where the property adjoins residential lots. Cefendant admits the purpose of the work was to level and grade and clear the area so that it could be used for the parking of cars. He claims however that in prior years customers have parked five to six cars there. There was testimony that a tree in this area was removed in June 1976. The tree was located approximately eight to nine fast into this area from its easterly side.

The area was inspected by the Court on January 31, 1977 At this time the former location of the tree, the foundation wall, and the former grade of land were pointed out by the Defendant and the Complainant in the presence of the Building Inspector.

The Building Inspector testified that when he visited the property in May 1970 for the purpose of determining the number of cars parked in the lot, he found the lot filled to capacity of 68 cars. He stated that he did not recall observing any car parked in the subject area. Complainant testified that he had not observed cars parked in the area since he has resided there for the past eight years, with the exception of one car parked diagonally at the rear of the property partly in the subject area facing the rear fence. On the dates in question he found three cars parked facing the fence at the westerly side of the property in an area previously inaccessible. Two additional cars were parked facing the fence at the southerly side of the property in an area previously not used for parking. The re-

mainder of the lot was filled. The testimony of Jeff Gringeri revealed that prior to Mcramber 1976 at least one car could have been parked along the rear of the building not past the door although he could not recall observing one there. He stated that more than one car could not have been parked there during the past eight years.

It is apparent that the area was cleared for additional parking in November 1976. The Court finds, that more than one car could not have been parked there prior to clearing and grading.


The law is clear both in the zoning ordinance and the cases, that a non-conforming use is limited to the area it covers at the time of the enactment of the ordinance restriction and an increase in area which involves an expansion of facilities not previously utilized, is prohibited. It is clear from all the facts that this is what was done here. The property was cleared to expand the non-conforming parking facilities, thereby enlarging the area of use with it's consequent increase in business activity in the residential zone. This conduct is clearly prohibited under the zoning ordinance and pursuant to case law proscribing expansion of non-conforming uses.

Defense is therefore found guilty as charged. Beyond the parking of one car along the building in an area previously accessible for that purpose, the area in question cannot be used for oil street parking facilities. This opinion shall in no way be construed as a permit to park any more cars in the lot

However, if your license is a "pocket license," (a license not sited at a premises) and you wish to activate your license at a premises during any of the license terms referenced above, you must file a full 12-page application transferring the license from "pocket" status to the intended premises. Please contact your local issuing authority to comply with all requirements regarding the transfer.

I suggest that you contact the local issuing authority immediately to determine what steps are necessary to complete your license application renewal process.
