WHEREAS, the tax-exempt municipal bond market is a widely used source of capital for states, local governments, tribes, territories, and non-profit borrowers that finances a tremendous share of the nation's public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, state and local governments finance about three-quarters of the public infrastructure in the United States and use tax-exempt bonds to do so, with the federal government providing only about one-quarter of the investment; and

WHEREAS, federal tax exemption for municipal bonds, dating back to the 1800s and incorporated into the modern tax code in 1913, has been crucial for state and local governments to affordably finance critical infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, tax-exempt bonds offer borrowers to achieve a multiplier effect of 2.11, meaning that for every dollar, borrowers achieve \$2.11 in borrowing cost savings, thereby demonstrating the efficiency and effectiveness of this exemption in facilitating infrastructure investment; and

WHEREAS, tax-exempt bonds provide for essential infrastructure projects, such as roads, bridges, utilities, broadband, water and sewer systems, and hospitals, which are vital to the health and well-being of our community such that without such bonds, the cost of borrowing would be more expensive thereby causing an increase in taxes and fees that would place an undue burden on taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff finds and determines that tax-exempt municipal bonds provide an opportunity for economic development along its path, better facilitate the movement of agriculture products, equipment, and other goods, and increase safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City as follows: The Governing Body hereby encourages the New Jersey Congressional Delegation to assist the Township of Wyckoff, New Jersey, by preserving the tax-exempt status of municipal bonds by supporting and ensuring the protection of the federal tax exemption of municipal bonds.

Governor Tahesha Way, Governor Philip Murphy, and the New Jersey State League of Municipalities.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to rescind that appointment and retain new counsel for Tax Appeal matters; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee now wishes to appoint the firm of Cleary, Giacobbe, Alfieri, Jacobs, LLC, with offices located at 169 Ramapo Valley Road, Oakland, New Jersey 07436, to serve as Special Counsel – Tax Appeals pursuant with *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i)* and pursuant with *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4*; and

WHEREAS, Cleary, Giacobbe, Alfieri, Jacobs, LLC has completed and submitted the required Business Entity Disclosure Certification, which certifies that it has not made any reportable contributions in violation of *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.* within the past one-year period; and

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING \$825,000 FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS AND
CAPITAL EXPENDITURES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The improvements described in Section 3 of this ordinance are hereby authorized by the Township of Wyckoff, and there is hereby appropriated the sum of money herein stated as the appropriations made therefore and amounting to \$825,000.

Section 2. For the financing of said improvements, and to meet the cost therefore, there is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the Township of Wyckoff, the said sum, being available by virtue of a provision included in the approved 2025 Municipal Budget.

Section 3. The improvements authorized and the appropriations therefore are for the purchase of live scan fingerprint machine, engineering services for road and facility improvements, improvements to public buildings and facilities, purchase of safety equipment for firefighters, hose replacement, purchase recreation program equipment, park and recreation area enhancements, various Town Hall and Public Works complex improvements, public safety equipment, purchase of DPW heavy equipment, police patrol SUV and equipment, radio and radar upgrades, Police Officer rifle upgrade, recreation field improvements, Municipal Stormwater upgrades and various other capital improvements, and safety enhancements.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
