The State took over their collection and never provided municipal governments with the full statutory distribution of ETR and CMTRA because the State retains for State use the revenue increases in those taxes. <u>Section 2.</u> For the financing of said improvement, and to meet the cost therefore, the sum of \$50,000.00 is hereby appropriated from Capital Improvement Fund and \$16,000 from Capital Fund Balance for the Township of Wyckoff.

<u>Section 3.</u> The improvement authorized and the appropriation therefore is for the purchase of and upfitting of two police pursuit sport utility vehicles.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.

ORDINANCE #1970

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 157, "SEWERS", ARTICLE IV," BUILDING SEWER CONNECTIONS", SECTION 25, "LAYING OF BUILDING SEWER LATERALS", AND OTHER PRINTED MATERIALS TO PRIVATE PREMISES.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Sewer Committee, upon the recommendation of the Township Engineer, that there is a need to permit different materials in the construction of sewer laterals than is currently permitted by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Committee has determined that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the Township to amend the Ordinance giving the Township Engineer the flexibility to permit different materials when it is appropriate and when such substitution will not impact the health, safety, or welfare of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I. §157-25 is hereby amended to read as follows [additions bracketed in bold type, deletions in bold type with strikethrough]:

§ 157-25 Laying of building sewer laterals.

Where determined by the Township Engineer to be feasible, the building sewer laterals for new construction shall be brought to the building at an elevation below the basement floor. The laterals for existing buildings may be brought to the building below the basement floor (for basement service by gravity) if determined by the Township Engineer to be feasible, or where there are no plumbing facilities requiring basement service or where approved artificial means of lifting basement sewage is provided, they may be brought to the building above the basement floor. Building sewer laterals shall not be laid parallel to or within three feet of any bearing wall, which might thereby be weakened. The building connection shall not be laid in the same trench as the water service connection or any other public utility, and they shall be provided with a minimum horizontal separation of five feet where practical. If horizontal separation is impractical, the building sewer lateral shall be placed at a lower elevation than, and at least 18 inches below, the bottom of the water service line. The depth shall be sufficient to afford protection

from frost. The building sewer lateral shall be laid at uniform grade and be properly bedded in granular material with no point loading. Changes in direction shall be made only with fittings of not greater than 45°. Cleanouts shall be placed outside the foundation at the connection point between the building drain and the building sewer lateral and at every change in direction, and at approximately equal intervals of no more than 75 feet in straight runs. The building sewer lateral from the building shall connect to the building sewer lateral at the property line via a cleanout. The cleanout at the property line and the pipe located within the public right-of-way shall be six-inch ductile iron pipe, or of another material, as may be determined by the Township Engineer, to the point of connection with the public sewer main.

SECTION II. All other parts, portions, and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed, except in the event of an inconsistency with the foregoing. In the event of any such inconsistency, the terms and provisions of Section I hereof shall be deemed to govern.

SECTION III. Should any part, portion, or provision of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any other part thereof.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and final passage according to law.

ORDINANCE #1971

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SALARY ORDINANCE #1963 AND FIXING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN TOWN HALL EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. That the salaries and compensation of various paid officers and employees of the Township of Wyckoff shall be at the following rates:

<u>Department/Position</u>	<u>Salary Range</u>
Subcode Inspectors	up to \$ 45.00 per hour
Assistant Tax Assessor	up to \$ 55,000 per year

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed but only to the extent of said inconsistency. All other parts of Ordinance #1963 of the Township of Wyckoff not inconsistent herewith are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. The salaries recorded above shall be effective as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
