BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Committee hereby authorize Mayor Rudolf E. Boonstra to be a signatory to the aforesaid Contract; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Committee hereby acknowledge that, in general, the use of this Trust Fund grant towards this approved park project must be completed by or about December 15, 2023; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Committee acknowledge that the grant will be disbursed to the municipality as a reimbursement upon submittal of certified Trust Fund payment and project completion documents and municipal vouchers, invoices, proofs of payment and other such documents as may be required by the County in accordance with the Trust Fund's requirements; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Committee acknowledge that the grant disbursement to the municipality will be the equivalent to fifty (50) percent of the eligible construction costs incurred (not to exceed total grant award) applied towards only the approved park improvements identified in the aforesaid Contract in accordance with the Trust Fund's requirements. Professional Services Costs may be reimbursed from grant award's unexpended balance, should there be a balance.

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff has been awarded a New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) Municipal Aid Grant of \$193,000 to regrade and resurface Grandview Avenue at its intersection with Route 208 to improve site distance when existing Route 208 to Grandview Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to act expeditiously to appoint the Professional Engineering firm to allow the engineering firm to perform all required work; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined to appoint Boswell Engineering due to their extensive experience with NJDOT Trust Fund Grants and environmental engineering experience as a full-service Engineering Consultant; and,

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent and the Chief Financial Officer have determined that the cost of these services may exceed \$17,500 and believe it is prudent to anticipate the value of these services in excess of \$17,500 to ensure compliance with NJSA 19:44A-20.5 et.seq.; and,

WHEREAS, each business entity has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that each business entity has not made any reportable contributions (\$300 or more) to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Wyckoff with the elected officials in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit each business entity from making any reportable contributions (\$300 or more) through the term of the contract; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee awards a one-year contract in accordance with the alternate process pursuant to the provisions of NJSA 19:44A-20.5; and,

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law NJSA 40A:11-5 requires the resolution authorizing award of contracts for professional services without competitive bids and the contract itself to be made available for public inspection; and,

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, has duly executed a Certificate of Available of Funds indicating that adequate funds have been appropriated in the 2021 Temporary Budget and will be appropriated in the 2021 Municipal Budget when adopted for fees reasonably required in the line items: engineering services and cost-other expense, various developers trust accounts and other expense accounts for capital projects are created when projects are funded due to the receipt of a grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff that a one year contract for the work required to satisfy all State requirements to perform the Grandview Avenue improvement is hereby awarded to Boswell Engineering, 330 Phillips Avenue, South Hackensack, NJ 07606, \$153.00 per hour, up to \$59.000.00 for the preparation of construction plans and specifications and providing construction inspection for the Grandview Avenue grading improvements, when approved by the Township Committee.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE RECEIPT, ACCEPTANCE AND DEPOSIT OF GRANT FUNDS THEREFORE AND TO AUTHORIZE APPROPRIATIONS OF \$96,000.

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff has made an application to the Bergen County Open Space Trust Fund Municipal Program for Park Improvement and Development to receive grant funds for improvements to the Russell Farms Community Park walking trail, Block 377/Lot 18.05; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff has received a notice that it is the recipient of a grant in the amount of \$48,000 for the improvements to Russell Farms Community Park walking trail; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff has entered into a contract with the Bergen County Open Space Trust Fund Program to participate in the receipt of grant funds made available.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Township of Wyckoff, in the County of Bergen shall proceed with improvements to Russell Farms Community Park which shall include completion of the construction of the walking trail with Flexi-Pave material.

SECTION 2. The cost of implementing said improvements in Section 1 shall be paid by the Township out of funds to:

SECTION 4. The monies which the Township of Wyckoff is authorized to receive pursuant to the terms of the Bergen County Open Space Trust Fund Program, shall, when received, be placed in a capital improvement fund of the Township of Wyckoff for the purpose set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. It is hereby determined and stated that no supplemental debt statement is required to be made and signed in connection with said purpose, since the gross debt of the Township of Wyckoff as defined under the Local Bond Law is not increased by this Ordinance, and no obligations in the matter of notes or bonds are authorized by this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect after publication thereof and final passage as required by law.
