

## TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF

OPMA Statement: The Wyckoff Township Committee shall meet today , 3-15-2020 at 2:30PM in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor court room of the Town Hall, 340 Franklin Ave, Wyckoff NJ to address the impact of the global COVID – 19 pandemic. The need for this emergency meeting is due to the rapidly spreading virus, as the number of confirmed cases has increased from 19 reported cases this past Friday to 31 reported cases today in Bergen county. The emergency meeting is necessary to ensure the continuance of the business of government while protecting the Municipal employees and residents. The Township has issued a robust public information effort which includes advising the public to refrain from visiting Town hall if they are experiencing flu like symptoms or if they have been in contact with an individual who is experiencing COVID - 19 virus symptoms. Therefore the Township Committee will discuss closing physical access to Town Hall while simultaneously maintaining the continuity of government business via phone, email, website, and/or other non-physical contact means of communication during the period of 3-16-20 through 3-30-2020 or similar time period. The Township Committee will discuss all issues and potential precautions with respect to the pandemic and the necessary efforts to ensure health, safety and welfare of the residents and the employees.

Pursuant to NJSA 14:4-9 b (1), The meeting must be authorized by an affirmative vote of three quarters of the members present. Discussion shall be limited with respect to issues regarding the emergency health situation.

Notice of such meeting has been provided by posting the same on the Clerk's bulletin board in Town hall and by notifying the Bergen Record and Ridgewood News by delivering written notice. The public body could not have reasonably foreseen the need for the meeting at a time when adequate notice could have been provided.
