2018 WYCKOFF MEMORIAL DAY PARADE ***"Honor Their Bravery, Remember Their Sacrifice"***

Wyckoff's Memorial Day ceremonies and parade are scheduled for Monday, May 28th.

- Ceremonies will begin at 8:30 am at Firehouse No. 1, directly behind Town Hall, where everyone is invited to attend the Firefighter's Memorial Service. This service honors all deceased Wyckoff firefighters.
- A Veteran's Memorial Service will be held at 10:00 a.m. on The Green of the Wyckoff Reformed Church on Wyckoff Avenue, site of the Township's War Memorial. All local Gold Star Mothers, Blue Star Mothers, Military Veterans and the community are invited to attend the service and parade. In the event of rain, the parade will be canceled and the memorial service will be held inside the church.
- The parade begins at 11:30 am at Cornerstone Christian Church, which is at the intersection of Wyckoff and Russell Avenues. The staging area for parade participants is behind Cornerstone Christian Church. The parade will proceed from the Cornerstone Christian Church and proceed left on Wyckoff Avenue, turn right onto Main Street, turn right onto Franklin Avenue and left into Town Hall and end at the Ambulance Corps building.

During the 10:00 a.m. Veterans Memorial Service, Erik Ruebenacker, Midland Park-Wyckoff VFW Post #7086 will be the Master of Ceremonies. The Honorable Brian D Scanlan, Mayor of Wyckoff will give the welcoming address. This year's Parade Grand Marshal is Harry Hammond, Korean War Veteran, U.S. Army. The Invocation and Benediction will be given by Father Stephen Fichter, Pastor, Saint Elizabeth's Church, and the vocalist is Cheryl Spierer-Wyka from Saint Elizabeth's Church who will be accompanied by the Saint Elizabeth's Children's Choir. Also, as part of the Memorial Service will be the recognition of the Midland Park-Wyckoff VFW Post #7086 Patriot's Pen Contest winners.

Following the parade refreshments will be provided behind Fire Company #1, courtesy of the Township Committee and Stop & Shop. Also behind Fire Company #1 will be DJ music and judging of the annual Patriotic Decorated Bicycle Contest.
