AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 49 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF, "LENGTH OF SERVICE PROGRAM", SECTION 49-5 "POINTS", SCHEDULE A, FIRE DEPARTMENT POINT SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Section 49-5, "Points" is amended as follows:

SECTION 1 – Section 49-5, "Points"

Schedule A

LOSAP Point System 100 Points Needed for a Qualifying Year

FIRE DEPARTMENT POINT SYSTEM

1. Fire Department Responses - 50 points maximum, 30 points minimum; points are credited based upon the following schedule of percent attendance at the Fire Department Responses to which the Wyckoff Volunteer Fire Department has been dispatched:

	40% Attendance	50 Points
4	30% Attendance	40 Points
	20% Attendance	30 Points

2. Drills - 40 points maximum, 20 points minimum; points are credited for participation in Fire Company, Department, and Mutual Aid and Special Drills.

2 points per drill, minimum 90 minute drill, minimum of 10 drills to qualify for any points.

- **3.** Training 50 points maximum; points are credited for Certified Firematic Training Courses upon receipt of certificate of completion, including all mandated training courses.
 - A. Courses under 20 hours duration 2 points per hour, with a maximum of 10 points per course.
 - B. Courses 20 to 45 hours duration 2 points per hour for each hour over 20 hours, with a maximum of 20 points per course.
 - C. Courses over 45 hours duration 2 points per hour, 330 points per course.

4. Holder of an Elected Specified Position - 50 points maximum; points are credited for completion of one-year term in an elected position. Only one position can be credited per year.

- 5. Meetings 30 points maximum, 6 points minimum; points will be credited for attendance at regular fire company meetings and qualifying departmental meetings, relief and exempt association meetings and Northwest Bergen Mutual Aid Meetings.
 - 2 Points per meeting with a minimum of 3 meetings to qualify for any points.
- 6. Stand-by or Sleep-in 20 points maximum;
 - A. Stand-by: 2 points each a stand-by is defined as line of duty activity of the Volunteer Fire Company, lasting a minimum of four hours, not falling under one of the other categories.
 - B. Sleep-in: 2 points each full night.
- **7. Miscellaneous Activities 25 points maximum;** points will be credited for participation in the following activities which are deemed Official Fire Department Activities by the Board of Firematic Officers:

2 points per occurrence for each of the following activities (minimum 2 hour duration)

Work details Regularly scheduled clean-ups Preventative Maintenance of trucks and equipment
Fire Prevention Activities (exclusive of regular fire inspection activities)
Fund Raising Activities
Wakes and memorial services
Firematic competitions
Committee meetings (maximum of 4 meetings per committee per year)
Apparatus inspections
Wyckoff Memorial Day Parade

8. Mutual Aid, FAST Team and single Company Responses – 15 points maximum; Points will be credited for attendance Mutual Aid, FAST Team and single Company Responses.

1 Point per call with a minimum of 5 points to qualify.

Highlights of Plan

- 1. Member for one (1) year to be eligible to participate in plan.
- 2. Five (5) years of active service to be vested.
- 3. Eligible to collect no earlier than age 62 and no later than age 70.
- 4. Time served in active military service during plan participation will be substituted for qualification.
- 5. Members are entitled to buy back up to five years of service for time served prior to plan initiation.
- 6. Funds will be distributed in a lump sum at qualifying age and member election

<u>SECTION 2</u> – Except as hereby amended, all other sections of Chapter 49 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3 – This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
