2023 Permits for Cornerstone Church Commuter Park and Ride

Township of Wyckoff 2023 Commuter Park and Ride permits for the Cornerstone Christian Church rear parking lot will be available for sale to Wyckoff residents only from December 12th through December 16, 2022. The Township will be issuing one (1) parking permit per resident household for the period December 12th to December 16th, 2022. On December 19, 2022, residents may purchase, if available, a second permit for a family member. The fee for a resident commuter park & ride permit is \$130.00.

Beginning December 19th, parking permits, as available, may be purchased by both residents and non-residents. Non-residents may purchase one (1) permit per household. The fee for a non-resident commuter park and ride permit is \$310.00.

- Parking permits can be purchased from the Township Clerk's office at Town Hall.
- 2022 commuter park and ride permits will expire on December 31, 2022.
- A current driver's license must be provided by all commuter park and ride permit applicants.
- Purchasing a park and ride permit does not guarantee a parking space.
- Parking permits are non-transferable.
- Replacement fee for a lost or stolen parking permit is \$25.00.
- Commuters must back their cars into parking spaces.

The Cornerstone Church Commuter Park & Ride Program allows vehicles to park at this facility Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Dear Commuter:

Here is information on the parking policies and fees for the Wyckoff Municipal Park and Ride facility at the Cornerstone Christian Church.

Wyckoff Residents who intend to purchase Wyckoff Park and Ride parking permits for 2023 may do so at the Municipal Clerk's office in Town Hall beginning Thursday, December 12, 2022.

- Wyckoff Residents may purchase one (1) parking permit per household from the period December 12th to December 16th.
- Wyckoff Residents may purchase a second parking permit per household beginning December 19th.
- Both non-residents and residents may purchase available permits from December 19th.
- Purchasing a parking permit is not a guarantee of a parking space.
- Overflow parking in Community Park is limited to parking permit holders only.
- All cars must be <u>backed</u> into parking stalls allowing for a clear view of the parking permit that is hung on the rear-view mirror.
- Commuter parking is allowed only in the parking stalls striped in yellow; cars parked in parking stalls striped in white will be towed and ticketed.
- The Wyckoff Community Park is a "Smoke Free Zone".

APPLICATION:

- Complete the attached registration form in its entirety. A current driver's license must be presented if
 applying in person & a photocopy of a current driver's license must be attached to mailed and online
 applications. Parking permits will not be issued without complete vehicle information.
- The annual fee for a resident is \$130.00 and the annual fee for a nonresident is \$310. Fees may be paid by check (to the Township of Wyckoff) or with cash. Please do not put cash in the mail. Credit cards are only accepted for online applications. The replacement fee for a lost or stolen parking permit is \$25.00.
- The completed registration form and required fee can be mailed or hand delivered to the Office of the Municipal Clerk at Town Hall. The mailing address is listed above, and the office hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Purchasing a parking permit does not guarantee a parking space.
- Current 2022 Park & Ride Parking Permits will expire on December 31, 2022.

CHURCH REQUIREMENTS:

- Cornerstone Church property is a "Smoke Free Zone".
- There is a sign on the Cornerstone Christian Church property that stipulates parking is allowed only in the parking stalls striped in yellow for "Park and Ride" permit holders. An additional sign directs permit holders to an overflow parking area at the Wyckoff Community Park when the Church parking lot is full. Parking in other areas will result in a violation/fine.
