NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that sealed bids for the below listed service will be received by the Township of Wyckoff, Bergen County, New Jersey on Tuesday, July 28, 2020 on or before 11:00 AM prevailing time in the second-floor court room in Memorial Town Hall, 340 Franklin Avenue, Wyckoff, New Jersey. Bid submission is encouraged via certified mail or overnight delivery.

PRUNING, ELEVATING, REMOVAL OF SHADE TREES & STUMPS

Specifications may be obtained in the office of the Township Administrator, Room 106, Memorial Town Hall, 340 Franklin Avenue, Wyckoff, New Jersey. All bidders must use and complete all forms and must comply with every requirement contained in the specifications.

Each proposal must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, must be addressed to the Township of Wyckoff and plainly marked, **BID FOR SHADE TREE WORK.**

Each bidder is required to have obtained a Business Registration Act Certificate from the New Jersey Department of Treasury/Division of Revenue, 609-292-1730.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of NJSA 10:5-31 et. seq. and NJAC 17:27.

The Township Committee reserves the right to waive any technicalities in the bidding process in accordance with the law as may be deemed best for the interests of the Township of Wyckoff. The Township of Wyckoff also reserves the right not to consider any bids in accordance with the law. The contract, if awarded, shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid is responsive in all material aspects to the bid requirements.

Bidders shall not submit bids with qualifying conditions or provisions.

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SECTION I

INSTRUCTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS TO BIDDERS

1. The intent of the Township of Wyckoff is to have a responsive and responsible tree service contractor supervised by a New Jersey Certified Tree Expert, prune, elevate and remove shade trees and grind tree stumps in accordance with the specifications and in accordance with the best practices of the trade.
2. All work must be supervised by a N.J. Certified Tree Expert, under the direction of the contractor. **Bidders must submit a copy of the Certificate of the N.J. Certified Tree Expert (with their bid submission) who will supervise the work described in this specification.**
3. **All bidders shall submit (with their bid submission) the "Experience & Reference" Affidavit indicating a minimum of five (5) years experience in this type of work and listing the municipality name, street address, email address, telephone number and contact person of three (3) municipalities for whom they have performed similar work.**
4. The successful bidder shall present a Certificate of Insurance indicating minimum limits of \$500,000 for auto, workmen's compensation and comprehensive general liability. Bidders must sign the Township of Wyckoff's Hold Harmless Agreement, if awarded the contract.
5. There shall be no sub-contractors performing tree work.
6. The contractor shall begin work within ten (10) calendar days after the receipt of a contract purchase order, and contractor shall continue thereon without interruption until the work is completed. **The entire work shall be completed in forty-five (45) calendar days or less.** Failure in this regard shall place the contractor in default and shall reduce the amount payable to him by \$50 per day in excess of the forty-five (45) calendar days that the work is still not acceptable or complete. A working day is every day of the week except Sundays and holidays.
7. **The bidder shall be responsible for safeguarding the property of residents and citizens when performing his work so as not to damage lawns, shrubs, sidewalks, curbs, structures and vehicles on or off the public streets. The successful bidder shall be responsible to restore any damaged property to original condition if damage occurs. The contractor is to dispose of all resulting debris from the work performed, and to leave the area and road in a clean and orderly manner. Such disposal will be at the contractor's expense.**
8. In the event there is a question about a tree (i.e., not marked clearly, etc.) the bidder shall contact the Shade Tree secretary at 201-891-7000, ext #104 between 9AM-4PM.
9. All bids must be enclosed and received in a sealed envelope and plainly marked on the outside "**BID FOR SHADE TREE WORK.**"
10. Bids must be submitted in ink or typewritten only.

SECTION I - Instructions to bidders

11. The Proposal (cover) Sheet must be completed and signed by a company official in order to be accepted by the Township of Wyckoff as a valid bid.
12. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 submission of statement required for bidding on public contracts is required in the specific format of the Statement of Ownership Disclosure in this specification. No corporation, partnership, or limited liability company shall be awarded any contract nor shall any agreement be entered into for the performance of any work of the furnishing of any materials or supplies, the cost of which is to be paid with or out of any public funds, by the State, or any county, municipality or school district, or any subsidiary or agency of the State, or of any county, municipality or school district or by any authority, board, or commission which exercises governmental functions, unless prior to the receipt of the bid or accompanying the bid, of said corporation, said partnership, or said limited liability company there is submitted a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders in the corporation who own 10 percent or more of its stock, of any class, or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10 percent or greater interest therein, or of all members in the limited liability company who own a 10 percent or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder or partner or member is itself a corporation or partnership or limited liability company, the stockholders holding 10 percent or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning 10 percent or greater interest in that partnership, or the members owning 10 percent or greater interest in that limited liability company, as the case may be shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder, and individual partner, and member, exceeding the 10 percent ownership criteria established in this act, has been listed.
To comply with this section, a bidder with any direct or indirect parent entity which is publicly traded may submit the name and address of each publicly traded entity and the name and address of each person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest in the publicly traded entity as of the last annual filing with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission or the foreign equivalent, and, if there is any person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest, also shall submit links to the websites containing the last annual filings with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission or the foreign equivalent and the relevant page numbers of the filings that contain the information on each person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest.
13. A bid cannot be withdrawn after the expiration of the time set for receiving bids, nor can any changes in price or other details be made by letter, telegram or verbal statement.
14. Payment for services shall be made after receipt, inspection and acceptance of the tree services by the Shade Tree Commissioner Chairperson and within fifteen (15) calendar days of receipt of a properly certified and tabulated Township of Wyckoff voucher after it is presented to the Township Committee for review and approved for payment at a Township Committee public meeting.
15. All work must be completed in a safe manner.

SECTION I - Instructions to Bidders

16. Bids may be forwarded through the mail. However, the Township will not assume responsibility for those bids. It is the bidder's responsibility to see that bids are presented to the Purchasing Agent on the hour and at the specific room and place designated. The Township shall not be responsible for late postal or overnight delivery, nor shall postmark dates or overnight dates be considered in honoring of bids. The Township shall not be responsible for bidder's hand delivering bids who arrive late or to the wrong location.
17. THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER WHOSE BID IS ACCEPTED WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR ERROR ARISING FROM HIS FAILURE OR MISUNDERSTANDING OF THE REQUIREMENTS LISTED IN THE SPECIFICATIONS.
18. **SITE EXAMINATIONS AND ESTIMATES:**
Bidders are encouraged to make a site examination in order to make exact measurements and precise bid prices.
19. Specifications may be obtained at the office of the Township Administrator, Memorial Town Hall, Scott Plaza, Wyckoff, NJ.
20. Intentionally left blank.
21. Each proposal must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, must be addressed to the Township of Wyckoff and plainly marked on the outside of the envelope, "**BID FOR SHADE TREE WORK.**"
22. The Township reserves the right to award this bid in whole or in part. The Township reserves the right to not consider any or all bids which are non-responsive to the bid specification and to waive any technicalities allowed by law and also reserves the right to select the successful bidder or bidders whose proposal does, in the opinion of the Township Committee, best meet the needs of the Township.
23. Any questions regarding this bid should be referred to Mr. Robert J. Shannon, Jr., Township Administrator, at 201-891-7000 on weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

SECTION I - Instructions to Bidders

24. During the performance of this contract:
 - (a) The parties to this contract agree to incorporate into this contract the mandatory affirmative action language of subsection 3.4(a) of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to NJSA 10:5-31 et. seq and NJAC 17:27, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and obligations of said subsection 3.4(a) provided that said subsection shall be applied subject to the terms of subsection 3.4(d) of said Regulations.
 - (b) The parties to this contract agree to incorporate into this contract the mandatory affirmative action language of section 5.3 of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to NJSA 10:5-31 et. seq and NJAC 17:27, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and obligations of said section 5.3.
25. All bidders to be considered, a responsive bidder shall have in their employ or have contracted for the services of a NJ Certified Tree Expert licensed by the State of New Jersey. **Copy of said certificate is required to be submitted with the bid proposal.**
26. The contractor shall be cognizant that all work is performed on the public right-of-way and as such, must keep the right-of-way clean and passable for pedestrians, school children and vehicles.
27. The Township is exempt from all taxes including Federal Excise Tax, Transportation Taxes, State Excise and sales tax, and local taxes.
28. Bid prices are to remain firm for a period of not less than sixty (60) days to allow the Township to determine the lowest bid that shall most economically serve the intentions of this bid.
29. Equal or tie bids. The Township of Wyckoff reserves the right to award at its discretion to any one of the tie bidders in any procedure it deems in the best interest of the Township of Wyckoff.
30. It is understood and agreed that all prices quoted are firm and not subject to any increase during the life of the contract. Should there be any reduction in successful bidder(s) prices as submitted, vendor agrees that all deliveries made on and after such date of price reduction will be invoiced on the basis of reduced prices.
31. The successful bidder shall be responsible for providing an Affirmative Action valid employee information report or completing and providing to the Wyckoff Administrator an Affirmative Action 302 form after notification of apparent low bidder and prior to contract award date as notified by the Township Administrator. Failure to comply will void any award.

SECTION I - Instructions to Bidders

32. **Bidders shall sign the attached Non-Collusion Affidavit and submit in them bid proposals.**
33. The contractor, by submitting a bid, attests to the fact that neither he or she, his or her company, nor any subcontractor are prohibited from receiving the award under N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.38 (regarding State of New Jersey list of debarred contractors and subcontractors).
34. The successful bidder(s) will be required to execute a purchase order contract which will include all terms, conditions, and specification documents. No terms or conditions other than those set forth in the specifications shall be permitted in the purchase order contract documents, nor will any form of contract submitted by the successful bidder be accepted by the Township of Wyckoff in lieu of the Township's form of contract. The successful bidder shall not change any specification conditions in any way during the contract period.
35. The apparent low bidder shall be responsible to submit to the Township of Wyckoff the following requirements after the bid opening when they are notified, they are the apparent low bidder and before a contract award date.
 - a. In accordance with P.L. 2009, c.315. a Business Registration Certificate (BRC) issued by the NJ Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue. The apparent low bidder shall have obtained the BRC prior to receipt of bids.The apparent low bidder shall be responsible for providing an Affirmative Action valid employee information report or completing and providing to the Wyckoff Administrator an Affirmative Action 302 form after notification of apparent low bidder and prior to contract award date.
36. The successful bidder will provide all necessary tools and equipment required to start and complete the job. **This will include cranes, chippers and/or bucket trucks as may be needed.**
37. Successful bidder(s) shall indemnify and save and keep harmless the Township of Wyckoff against any and all claims for royalties, patent infringements or suits for information thereon which may be involved in the manufacture or use of the items to be furnished.
38. The contractor shall comply with all New Jersey State and Federal Laws as they pertain to the performance under the contract.
39. Should any differences arise between the contracting parties as to the meaning or intent of these instructions or specifications, the Township of Wyckoff's Purchasing Agent's decision shall be final and conclusive.
40. If the price bid is different in numbers and words, the price bid in words shall be determined as the official price bid.

SECTION I - Instructions to Bidders

41. Bidders shall not change or modify any of the Township of Wyckoff's requirements Listed in this specification.
42. Any prospective bidder who wishes to challenge a bid specification may file such challenges in writing with the contracting agent no less than three (3) business days prior to the opening of the bids. Challenges filed after that time shall be considered void and have no impact on the contracting unit or the award of a specification.
43. The provision or performance of goods or services under this specification and by the successful vendor, shall not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, sex, national origin, creed, color, ancestry, age, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, familial status, liability for service in the Armed Forces of the United States or nationality.
44. No official, employee or agent of the Township of Wyckoff is permitted to accept gift(s) from vendors or other conducting business with the Township of Wyckoff.
45. Property Damage. The Contractor shall be held responsible for all damages or injury done by those in his employ to a Township vehicle and equipment. The Contractor shall restore or repair, at his own expense in a manner satisfactory to the owner, such property as was damaged by those in his employ during the execution of the project. In case of failure on the part of the Contractor to restore or repair such property in the manner satisfactory to the owner, the Township Administrator may, upon 48 hours' notice to the Contractor, proceed to make such repairs or restore such property, that in his judgment, has been injured or damaged by the Contractor or those in his employ, and the cost thereof will be deducted from any monies due or which may become due the Contractor under this contract.
46. The Township requires the tree preservation and removal work in this specification to be performed in accordance with the best practices of the trade for longevity of the trees. The Township has determined that based on experience, this is accomplished by a bidder whom employs a NJ Certified Tree Expert who supervises this work. Therefore, the Township has made this a requirement of the work.
47. Insurance Requirements: The Contractor shall be required to carry full insurance including comprehensive General Liability; Produce Liability; Worker's Compensation Insurance, which shall cover all operations of the Contractor, its employees, agents and officials hereunder and motor vehicles and equipment used by the Contractor in connection with the Contractor's operations under the contract. Said insurance, by endorsement, shall fully protect the Township from liability. Certificates designating the Township as an additional insured, and evidencing such insurance and coverage shall be filed with the Township Administrator prior to the commencement of operations hereunder by the Contractor. Certificates so filed shall further contain a statement which shall, in effect, say "the limits requested represent minimum limits and in no way restrict your liability for any claims in excess of your policy limits."

48. The methodology of award shall be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder whose sum of the prices bid for pruning, elevation and removal of hanging branches and tree removal work and stump grinding is the lowest total price.
49. When a business entity has received \$50,000.00 or more in public contracts from public entities, the business entity shall file a report with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC). www.elec.state.nj.us is the ELEC website.
50. Bidder should be aware of the following statutes that represent "Truth in Contracting" laws:
- NJSA 2C:21-34, et seq. governs false claims and representations by bidders. It is a serious crime for the bidder to knowingly submit a false claim and/or knowingly make material misrepresentation.
 - NJSA 2C:27-10 provides that a person commits a crime if said person offers a benefit to a public servant for an official act performed or to be performed by a public servant, which is a violation of official duty.
 - NJSA 2C:27-11 provides that a bidder commits a crime if said person, directly or indirectly, confers or agrees to confer any benefit not allowed by law to a public servant.
 - Bidder should consult the statutes or legal counsel for further information.

SECTION I - Instructions to Bidders

51. **Only the terms and conditions of this bid specification and the Wyckoff Municipal Purchase Order shall govern transactions.** The bidder shall not attach any other Terms & Conditions to their Bid Proposal. A bidder whose Bid Proposal attaches any Terms & Conditions shall be considered a non-responsive bid and that bid shall not be considered for an award.
52. In accordance with NJAC 17:44-2.2, the vendor, shall maintain all documentation related to products, transactions or services under this contract for a period of five (5) year from the date of final payment. Such records shall be made available to the New Jersey Office of the State Comptroller upon request.
53. **CAUTION:** Obtaining the plans and specifications from anyone other than the Township of Wyckoff may result in an inadequate or non-responsive bid if an addendum is issued and you are not on the distribution list of vendors.

54. **ANY VENDOR OBTAINING A COPY OF THIS SPECIFICATION FROM ANY SOURCE OR SERVICE OTHER THAN FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF SHALL BE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE TO BE KNOWLEDGEABLE OF ALL ADDENDA, CANCELLATIONS OR POSTPONEMENTS RELATED TO THIS PROCUREMENT.**

The Township of Wyckoff shall not be responsible to issue addenda in accordance with the Local Public Contractor Law for vendors who have elected to obtain a specification from any non-municipal source. When a vendor obtains a specification from any source or service other than from the Township of Wyckoff, the vendor does not provide its contact information which allows the municipality to know who has obtained specifications should the municipality have to issue an addendum, cancellation or postponement notices.

55. **IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE VENDOR TO BE KNOWLEDGEABLE TO ALL ADDENDA, CANCELLATIONS OR POSTPONEMENTS RELATED TO THIS PROCUREMENT.**
56. **THE APPARENT LOW BIDDER SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE COPIES OF ITS BUSINESS REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE (BRC) AND ITS AFFIRMATIVE ACTION COMPLIANCE EVIDENCE PRIOR TO THE DATE OF CONTRACT AWARD. BIDDERS ARE REQUESTED TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THEIR BRC AND A COPY OF THEIR AFFIRMATIVE ACTION COMPLIANCE EVIDENCE WITH THEIR BID SUBMISSION AS A CONVENIENCE AND NOT A REQUIREMENT.**
57. Payment shall be made after all work is completed and a properly completed Township of Wyckoff voucher is received (No partial payments shall be made) and Scott Fisher, Public Works Manager inspects the tree work and stump grinding. The Township pays its bills twice per month. Please notify the Shade Tree Commission Secretary each day that the work is performed and the location of the work to allow on-going inspections of completed work to take place.
58. The contractor shall sign a certification that attest to the fact that all work has been performed in accordance with the specification and such certification shall be countersigned by a Notary Public in the state of New Jersey and attached to the payment voucher.

MANDATORY EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY LANGUAGE
GOODS, PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AND GENERAL SERVICE CONTRACTS
(Mandatory Affirmative Action Language)

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the contractor will ensure that equal employment opportunity is afforded to such applicants in recruitment and employment that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Such equal employment opportunity shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor, will send to each labor union, with which it has a collective bargaining agreement, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer advising the labor union of the contractor's commitments under this chapter and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to meet targeted county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing its appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personnel testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

In conforming with the applicable employment goals, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

The contractor shall submit to the public agency, after notification of award but prior to execution of a goods and services contract, one of the following three documents:

Letter of Federal Affirmative Action Plan Approval

Certificate of Employee Information Report

Employee Information Report Form AA302 (electronically provided by the Division and distributed to the public agency through the Division's website at www.state.nj.us/treasury/contract/compliance).

The contractor and its subcontractors shall furnish such reports or other documents to the Division of Purchase & Property, CCAU, EEO Monitoring Program as may be requested by the office from time to time in order to carry out the purposes of these regulations, and public agencies shall furnish such information as may be requested by the Division of Purchase & Property, CCAU, EEO Monitoring Program for conducting a compliance investigation pursuant to Subchapter 10 of the Administrative Code at N.J.A.C. 17:27.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990
Equal Opportunity for Individuals with Disability

The contractor and the Township of Wyckoff, (hereafter "owner") do hereby agree that the provisions of Title 11 of the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 (the "Act") (42 U.S.C. S121 01 et seq.), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by public entities in all services, programs, and activities provided or made available by public entities, and the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant there unto, are made a part of this contract. In providing any aid, benefit, or service on behalf of the owner pursuant to this contract, the contractor agrees that the performance shall be in strict compliance with the Act. In the event that the contractor, its agents, servants, employees, or subcontractors violate or are alleged to have violated the Act during the performance of this contract, the contractor shall defend the owner in any action or administrative proceeding commenced pursuant to this Act. The contractor shall indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner, its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages, of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of the alleged violation. The contractor shall, at its own expense, appear, defend, and pay any and all charges for legal services and any and all costs and other expenses arising from such action or administrative proceeding or incurred in connection therewith. In any and all complaints brought pursuant to the owner's grievance procedure, the contractor agrees to abide by any decision of the owner which is rendered pursuant to said grievance procedure. If any action or administrative proceeding results in an award of damages against the owner, or if the owner incurs any expense to cure a violation of the ADA which has been brought pursuant to its grievance procedure, the contractor shall satisfy and discharge the same at its own expense.

The owner shall, as soon as practicable after a claim has been made against it, give written notice thereof to the contractor along with full and complete particulars of the claim, If any action or administrative proceeding is brought against the owner or any of its agents, servants, and employees, the *owner shall* expeditiously forward or have forwarded to the contractor every demand, complaint, notice, summons, pleading, or other process received by the owner or its representatives.

It is expressly agreed and understood that any approval by the owner of the services provided by the contractor pursuant to this contract will not relieve the contractor of the obligation to comply with the Act and to defend, indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner pursuant to this paragraph.

It is further agreed and understood that the owner assumes no obligation to indemnify or save harmless the contractor, its agents, servants, employees and subcontractors for any claim which may arise out of their performance of this Agreement. Furthermore, the contractor expressly understands and agrees that the provisions of this indemnification clause shall in no way limit the contractor's obligations assumed in this Agreement, nor shall they be construed to relieve the contractor from any liability, nor preclude the owner from taking any other actions available to it under any other provisions of the Agreement or otherwise at law.

 - g. The successful bidder shall include grinding of stumps on trees that have been removed. Stump grinding must be completed within fifteen (15) calendar days after the tree has been removed within the total 45 calendar days allowed for all work.
 - h. All elevating of branches shall be performed at the entire circumference of the tree to achieve a tree whose lower dead and/or smaller branches have been elevated in an aesthetic manner. It is not acceptable to just elevate the branches which extend over the roadway area. When pruning lower dead branches, the aforementioned aesthetic objective shall be achieved by the bidder. Branches shall be elevated to the height of 15' or a practical height in proportion to and based on the existing height of the tree.

- a. The trees to be removed are located along the municipal streets in the right-of-way on the attached list.
 - b. All trees removed shall **include the grinding of stumps** and the work shall include the removal of all logs, brush, chips and debris from premises and include cost of dumping. Stump grinding must be performed within fifteen (15) calendar days after the tree has been removed. Failure in this regard shall place the contractor in default and shall reduce the amount payable to him by \$50 per day in excess of the forty working days that the work is not complete.

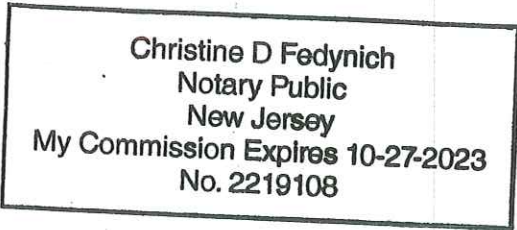

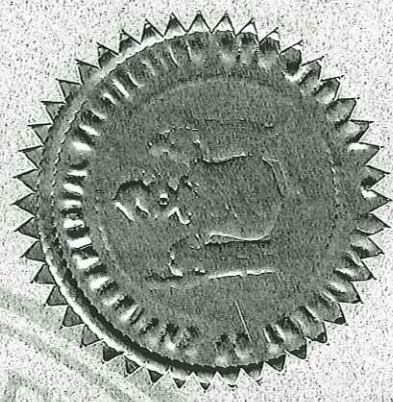

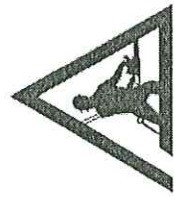
