PLEASE DO NOT DEPOSIT DOG DROPPINGS INTO A NEIGHBOR'S TRASH OR IN A STORM DRAIN!



- Please respect another person's property. The Township ordinances require a person walking a dog on a leash to curb the dog and immediately remove all feces deposited by the animal and place it in a waterproof container properly sealed and then disposed of in your garbage container.
- The N.J. Stormwater Management Act is a government mandate to control the runoff of water from rain or snow. With each rain and snowfall, pollutants are washed down the streets and lawns into stormwater drains that flow into our waterways and ocean.

Dog waste is POLLUTED runoff that can get into our water supply!
