1. WHAT TO BRING

- Gloves
- First aid kit
- Reusable water bottle
- Trash bags, recycling bags
- Neon safety t-shirt (reuse last years t-shirt)
- Instructions
- Friends, co-workers from school, clubs, church, etc.

2. SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Minors must be accompanied & supervised by an adult
- Minors to be supervised to avoid streets, roadways & waterways
- Wear bright color clothes and closed toe shoes
- Bring sunscreen, reusable water bottle & keep hydrated
- Notify group leaders of allergies or any physical limitations
- Do not walk in creeks, streams or wetland areas





- Never touch medical or hazardous waste
- Park vehicles a safe distance from roadways
- Avoid hazardous materials such as car batteries or any unidentified questionable items and animal carcasses
- Stay clear of all construction areas.
- Be careful of contact with poison plants, bees, wasps, hornets, fire ants, and snakes. T
- Be aware of visibility problems & attempt to walk facing on-coming traffic.
- DO NOT stand or jump on guardrails, drainage pipes or concrete walls
- ANY EMERGENCIES CONTACT 911 IMMEDIATELY

3. RECYCLE RIGHT!

PLASTICS, GLASS & CANS

Bottles, Cans, Plastic # 1, 2 & 5 and coated milk and juice cartons. Lids and caps are trash



RECYCLE IN CLEAR BAGS



MIXED PAPER, NEWSPAPER, CARDBOARD & CORRUGATED BOARD

Board (non-coated) acceptable Items include: magazines, books, cereal boxes, paper towels, junk mail, office paper, etc.

RECYCLE IN CLEAR BAGS (not with paper)

ALL OTHER ITEMS ARE TRASH

PUT IN BLACK TRASH BAGS

Such as plastic bags, pizza boxes, tanglers & ropes.



PLEASE LEAVE ALL BAGS AT THE SIDE OF THE ROAD AND NOT ON THE STREETS. DPW WILL PICK UP ALL BAGS!
