Each proposal must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, must be addressed to the Township of Wyckoff and plainly marked, "BID FOR FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT."

Each bidder is required to have a Business Registration Act certificate from the New Jersey Department of Treasury/Division of Revenue, 609-292-1730.

Bidders shall not submit bids with qualifying conditions or provisions.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

The Township Committee reserves the right to waive any technicalities in the bidding process in accordance with the law as may be deemed best for the interests of the Township of Wyckoff. The Township of Wyckoff also reserves the right not to consider any bids in accordance with the law. The contract, if awarded, shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid is responsive in all material respects to the bid requirements.

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Section I - INSTRUCTION & REQUIREMENTS

- The intent of this specification is for the Township of Wyckoff (the Lead Agency) to make contract awards
 to competent and qualified firefighting equipment suppliers who submit responsive and responsible bids
 reflecting the lowest individual unit price to supply the various new, never been used before, current model
 firefighting equipment specified in Section II.
 - A. Bidders are advised that the Township of Wyckoff (the Lead Agency) for the Wyckoff, Oakland and Franklin Lakes Cooperative Pricing Group is advertising for competitive bids and shall received bids on behalf of the three participating contract units. Following the receipt of bids, the Lead Agency shall review said bids and on behalf of all participating contracting units, either not consider any bid(s) not responsive to the specification or make awards to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) for each separate individual unit item. The Lead Agency shall make a contract award resolution with the successful bidder(s) providing for two categories of purchases:
 - 1. The quantities purchased for the Lead Agency's own needs; and
 - The estimated aggregate quantities to be ordered by other participating contracting units by separate contracts, subject to the specification and prices set forth in the Lead Agency's Resolution of Contract Award.
 - B. The Lead Agency shall issue contract(s) directly with the successful bidder(s) only after it has certified the funds available for its own needs.
 - C. Each participating contracting unit shall also certify the funds available only for its own needs ordered; enter into a formal written contract, when required by law, directly with the successful bidder(s); issue purchase orders in its own name directly to successful bidder(s) against said contract; accept its own deliveries; be invoiced by and receive statements from the successful bidder(s); make payment directly to the successful bidder(s) and be responsible for any tax liability.
 - D. No participating contracting unit in the Cooperative Pricing System shall be responsible for payment for any items ordered or for performance generally, by any other participating contracting unit. Each participating contracting unit shall accordingly be liable only for its own performance and for items ordered and received by it and none assumes any additional responsibility or liability.
 - E. Items 1a through 1d have been stated so that each bidder is on notice as to the respective responsibilities and liabilities of the participating contracting units.

- F. The successful bidder shall furnish and deliver firefighting equipment which they have been awarded contracts for, to the Lead Agency and the participating contracting units when ordered via a municipal purchase order, from date of award through December 31, 2020 at firm prices excluding all taxes, and including all transportation and delivery charges full prepaid F.O.B. destination, inside delivery, upstairs/downstairs with debris removed in accordance with the general specifications, requirements and schedules in the bid proposal at the following locations:

- G. The Township of Wyckoff reserves the right to make awards on the basis of the lowest unit price for each individual item. Therefore, bidders are encouraged to provide their most competitive price on each and every individual unit item.
- H. The quantities shown are approximate only, and the Township of Wyckoff and participating contracting units reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantities. These quantities are not intended to be either maximum or minimum requirements, rather estimated quantities as needed by the Lead Agency. The participating contracting units shall place orders between date of award and December 31, 2020, at the stated unit prices.

I. Delivery

- Unit prices <u>include delivery and</u> remain firm for the above period in the 2020 calendar year for the participating contracting units to place orders.
- J. The Township of Wyckoff has specified professional grade, current model firefighting equipment in the specification to encourage free, open and competitive bidding. If a brand name is listed, it is to be read as a brand name or approved equal.

Based on research, experience and the needs of the Township of Wyckoff Fire Department, the Township has determined the professional grade, current model firefighting equipment manufactured as described in the specification is of sufficient quality and durability required to perform the work of the Wyckoff Fire Department. For purposes of safety within the Township of Wyckoff and to allow for the ease of firematic procedures and for durability and long, useful life, the specifications reflect the needs of the Wyckoff Fire Department.

- 2. Bids must be submitted in ink or typewritten only.
- 3. The Proposal (cover) sheet must be completed and signed by a company official in order to be accepted by the Township of Wyckoff as a valid bid.

4. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 submission of statement required for bidding on required in the specific format of the Statement of Ownership public contracts is Disclosure in this specification. No corporation, partnership, or limited liability company shall be awarded any contract nor shall any agreement be entered into for the performance of any work of the furnishing of any materials or supplies, the cost of which is to be paid with or out of any public finds, by the State, or any county, municipality or school district, or any subsidiary or agency of the State, or of any county, municipality or school district or by any authority, board, or commission which exercises governmental functions, unless prior to the receipt of the bid or accompanying the bid, of said corporation, said partnership, or said limited liability company there is submitted a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders in the corporation who own 10 percent or more of its stock, of any class, or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10 percent or greater interest therein, or of all members in the limited liability company who own a 10 percent or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder or partner or member is itself a corporation or partnership or limited liability company, the stockholders holding 10 percent or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning 10 percent or greater interest in that partnership, or the members owning 10 percent or greater interest in that limited liability company, as the case may be shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder, and individual partner, and member, exceeding the 10 percent ownership criteria established in this act, has been listed.

To comply with this section, a bidder with any direct or indirect parent entity which is publicly traded may submit the name and address of each publicly traded entity and the name and address of each person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest in the publicly traded entity as of the last annual filing with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission or the foreign equivalent, and, if there is any person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest, also shall submit links to the websites containing the last annual filings with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission or the foreign equivalent and the relevant page numbers of the filings that contain the information on each person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest.

- 5. A bid cannot be withdrawn after the expiration of the time set for receiving bids, nor can any changes in price or other details be made by letter, fax, email or verbal statement.
- 6. Payment for firefighting equipment will be made after receipt, inspection and acceptance of the firefighting equipment by the Fire Chief and within fifteen (15) calendar days of receipt of a properly certified and tabulated Lead Agency or participating contracting unit voucher after it is presented to the respective governing body for review and approved for payment at the respective governing body public meeting.
- 7. The Township reserves the right to award contracts on the basis of lowest individual unit prices.
- 8. The Township reserves the right to not consider any or all bids which are non-responsive to the bid specification and to waive any technicalities allowed by law and also reserves the right to select the successful bidder or bidders whose proposal does, in the opinion of the Township Committee, best meet the needs of the Township.

- 9. All firefighting equipment must be constructed with industry standard materials, professional grade quality and must be delivered within seventy (70) calendar days from receipt of a municipal purchase order.
- 10. The successful bidder(s) will be responsible for receiving purchase orders and furnishing and delivery of firefighting equipment after receiving notice by the Lead Agency that a contract has been awarded.
- 11. All bids must be enclosed and received in a sealed envelope and plainly marked on the outside, "BID FOR FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT."
- 12. Any questions regarding this bid should be referred to Mr. Robert J. Shannon, Jr., Township Administrator, at 201-891-7000 on weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- 13. During the performance of this contract:
 - a. The parties to this contract agree to incorporate into this contract, the mandatory language of subsection 3.4 (a) of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975. C.127, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions, and obligations of said subsection 3.4 (a) provided that the said subsection shall be applied subject to the terms of subsection 3.4(a) of said regulations.
 - b. The parties to this contract agree to incorporate into this contract the mandatory language of section 5.3 of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, C.127, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and obligations of said Section 5.3
- 14. The Township of Wyckoff awards contracts or rejects all bids within sixty (60) days. Exception to this schedule would be in accordance with N.J.S. 40A:11-24, which provides that "any bidders who consent thereto may, at the request of the contracting unit, have their bids held for consideration for such longer period as may be agreed." All prospective bidders are advised of this schedule since bids must be firm when bid and must remain so for the sixty (60) days or longer or otherwise agreed to by the Township and the bidder.
- 15. The successful bidder(s) will be required to execute a purchase order contract which will include all terms, conditions, and specification documents. No terms or conditions other than those set forth in the specifications shall be permitted in the purchase order contract documents, nor will any form of contract submitted by the successful bidder be accepted by the Lead Agency in lieu of the Lead Agency's form of contract. The successful bidder shall not change any specification conditions in any way during the contract period.
- 16. THE SUCCESSFUL VENDOR(S) SHALL NOT ASSIGN, CONVEY, TRANSFER, SUBLET OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF THE CONTRACT OR ANY PART AND/OR TO ANY OTHER PERSON, COMPANY OR CORPORATION WITHOUT THE PRIOR WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE.

17. Bids may be forwarded through the mail. However, the Lead Agency will not assume responsibility for those bids. It is the bidder's responsibility to see that bids are presented to the Purchasing Agent on the hour and at the specific room and place designated.

The Lead Agency shall not be responsible for late postal or overnight delivery, nor shall postmark dates or overnight dates be considered in honoring of bids. The Lead Agency shall not be responsible for bidders' hand delivering bids who arrive late or to the wrong location.

- 18. THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER(S) WHO'S BID IS ACCEPTED WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR ERROR ARISING FROM HIS FAILURE OR MISUNDERSTANDING OF THE REQUIREMENTS LISTED IN THE SPECIFICATIONS.
- 19. The successful bidder shall be responsible for providing an Affirmative Action valid employee information report or completing and providing to the Wyckoff Administrator an Affirmative Action 302 form after the bid opening and prior to the contract award.
- 20. Bidders shall sign the attached Non-Collusion Affidavit.
- 21. The contractor, by submitting a bid, attests to the fact that neither he or she, his or her company, nor any subcontractor are prohibited from receiving the award under N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.38 (regarding State of New Jersey list of debarred contractors and subcontractors).
- 22. Equal or tie bids. The Lead Agency reserves the right to award at its discretion to any one of the tie bidders in any procedure it deems in the best interest of all participating contracting units.
- 23. Prices bid in all proposals shall be delivered prices, F.O.B. destination, freight prepaid, upstairs, downstairs, debris removed as specified in Item 1.
- 24. The Lead Agency and the member municipalities are exempt from all taxes including Federal Excise Tax, Transportation Taxes, State Excise and sales tax, and local taxes.
- 25. Bid prices are to remain firm for a period of not less than sixty (60) days to allow the Township to determine the lowest bid that shall most economically serve the intentions of this bid.
- 26. No bidder shall be allowed to offer more than one price on each item even though he/she has two or more type of styles that will meet specifications. Bidders shall bid their new, never been used before, current model firefighting equipment as specified, or approved equal. If said bidder should submit more than one price on any item, all prices for that item shall be considered a non-responsive bid and therefore not considered for an award.
- 27. It is understood and agreed that all prices quoted are firm and not subject to any increase during the life of the contract. Should thereby any reduction in successful bidder(s) prices as submitted, vendor agrees that all deliveries made on and after such date of price reduction will be invoiced on the basis of reduced prices.

- 28. It will be understood that all bids are based upon the specification unless the bidder stipulates to the contrary in letter form to be attached to bid submission. <u>Bidder shall not type changes on bid specification forms.</u> The letter shall point out in detail any and all deviations from the specification and how the deviations meets or exceeds the Lead Agency's service needs as listed in the specification.
- 29. When award of contract is made in one fiscal year with an effective date in the next fiscal year, award shall be contingent upon the availability of appropriation of sufficient funds for that purpose for the year in which said contract takes effect. When a contract shall be contingent upon the annual availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for that purpose for each year of the contract.
- 30. The contractor shall comply with all New Jersey State and Federal Laws as they pertain to the performance under the contract.
- 31. Should any differences arise between the contracting parties as to the meaning or intent of these instructions or specifications, the Township of Wyckoff's Purchasing Agent's decision shall be final and conclusive.
- 32. The successful vendor shall comply with all New Jersey State and Federal laws as they pertain to the performance required in this specification and contract award.
- 33. Bidders shall not change or modify any of the Lead Agency's requirements listed in this specification.
- 34. Any prospective bidder who wishes to challenge a bid specification may file such challenges in writing with the contracting agent no less than three (3) business days prior to the opening of the bids. Challenges filed after that time shall be considered void and have no impact on the contracting unit or the award of a specification.
- 35. The provision or performance of goods or services under this specification and by the successful vendor, shall not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, sex, national origin, creed, color, ancestry, age, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, familial status, liability for service in the Armed Forces of the United States, nationality or disability.
- 36. Bids may be forwarded through the mail. However, the Township will not assume responsibility for those bids. It is the bidder's responsibility for those bids. It is the bidder's responsibility to see that bids are presented to the Purchasing Agent on the hour and at the specific room and place designated. The Lead Agency shall not be responsible for late postal or overnight delivery, nor shall postmark dates or overnight dates be considered in honoring of bids. The Lead Agency shall not be responsible for bidder's hand delivering bids who arrive late or to the wrong location.
- 37. If the bidder bids the price in numbers different from the price in words, the Lead Agency will consider the price in words as the bidder's price.
- 38. No official, employee or agent of the participating contracting unit is permitted to accept gift(s) from vendors or others conducting business with the Lead Agency.



- 39. All materials or services furnished on a Purchase Order is specific and subject to the Lead Agency or the participating contracting units' inspection and approval within a reasonable time after delivery at the destination indicated on the Purchase Order. Materials or services other than those specified in this Purchase Order shall not be substituted without prior, written authority from the Lead Agency or the participating contracting units at their sole discretion. Material rejected will be returned at the vendor's risk and expense.
- 40. The Wyckoff Fire Chief who received the item(s) or service(s) is required to sign the Purchase Order, certifying all items were received in full as listed on the Purchase Order.
- 41. The Township can only purchase materials, supplies, equipment and vehicles via a fully executed Township of Wyckoff Purchase Order. Employees or officials do not have the authority to purchase on behalf of the Township of Wyckoff
- 42. The Township of Wyckoff does not pay any late fees or interest charges.
- 43. Should the bidders wish to state any exceptions or propose an approved equal to the specifications, he <u>must</u> do so on company letterhead attached to the formal bid referring to the section of the specification that the exception is taken. It is mandatory that the bidder list and explain in detail all exceptions and/or substitutions. The bidder shall explain in thorough and complete detail how the exception taken meets or exceeds the specification requirement. All must be neatly printed in ink or typed. Attaching sales information or specification sheet is not acceptable. It shall be clearly understood that if no exception or substitution is taken, the bidder shall supply all products and services exactly as specified. The bidder must, however, note on the Proposal Page and the technical specifications that exceptions and/or substitution or proposed equal are taken.

The bidders shall provide with the bid this information and in this form to allow the Township of Wyckoff to determine if the exception and/or deviation proposed by the bidder clearly meets or exceeds the specification requirement(s). Bidders failing to follow these instructions shall be determined by the Township Administrator to be a non-responsive bid to the specifications and will not be considered for an award.

All deviations shall include an attached sample of the proposed item to allow evaluation as to equivalency. Bid submissions that do not follow this procedure shall be considered non-responsive to the specifications and not be considered. Therefore, the bidder in completing a bid, understands this requirement and is fully aware that any deviation not listed on company letterhead, explaining and including an attached sample, will not be considered. The Township of Wyckoff shall be the sole determinant of what is an approved equal.

- 44. The Township's methodology for an award, if any, shall be to award contracts to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) who provides the lowest responsive and responsible individual unit price per item.
- 45. Should any differences arise between the contracting parties as to the meaning or intent of these instructions or specifications, the Township of Wyckoff's Purchasing Agent's decision shall be final and conclusive.

- 46. Upon expiration of this agreement, the terms of the agreement may be extended for such reasonable time as may be agreed upon by both parties, until such time as new proposals are received, accepted and awarded by the Township of Wyckoff. Such an extension shall not exceed ninety (90) days.
- 47. If an item or items need to be returned to the vendor due to the item being: a) damaged; b) incorrect item shipped or c) item not as per bid, the participating contracting unit shall advise the vendor within 36 hours of receipt of the item(s) of the need to return the item(s). The vendor is then required to provide for the pickup of said item(s) at the Town Hall and the replacement and shipping at the vendor's sole cost, if applicable, of said item(s) within ten (10) days to the participating contracting unit locations. All vendors are made aware of this procedure. All vendors submitting a bid agree to this procedure.
- 48. The proposal (cover) sheets must be completed and signed by a company official in order to be accepted by the Township of Wyckoff as a valid bid.
- 49. The Township Committee of the Township Committee reserves the right to reject any and all bids in accordance with the law.
- 50. If the bidder bids the price in numbers different from the price in words, the Township will consider the price in words as the bidders' price.
- 51. No official, employee or agent of the Township of Wyckoff is permitted to accept gift(s) from vendors or others conducting business with the Township of Wyckoff.

52. AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990

Discrimination on the basis of disability in contracting for the purchase of goods and services is prohibited. Bidders are required to read Americans with Disabilities language that is included in this specification and understand that the provisions of Title II of the Act are made a part of the contract. The contractor is obligated to comply with the Act and to hold the owner harmless.

53. BUSINESS REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE

In accordance with P.L. 2009, C.315, bidders shall have obtained a Business Registration Certificate (BRC) issued by the New Jersey Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue. The BRC is required to be submitted after the bid opening but before the contract award.

54. AFFIRMATIVE ACTION REQUIREMENTS

a. If bidders are notified that they are a successful bidder, those bidders shall be required to comply with the requirements of NJSA 10:5-31 et seq. and NJAC 17:27 et seq.

b. A <u>successful bidder</u> **shall submit** to the Township of Wyckoff, one of the following three (3) documents:

- 1) A photocopy of a *valid letter* identifying that the contractor is operating
 Under an existing federally approved or sanctioned Affirmative Action report.
- 2) A photocopy of a *Certificate of Employment Information Report* approval issued in accordance with NJAC 17:27-4, OR
- A photocopy of an Employee Information Report (Form AA302) provided by the Division of Purchase & Property, CCAU, EEO Monitoring Program and distributed to the public agency to be completed by the contractor in accordance with NJAC 17:27-4.

55. NEW JERSEY WORKER AND COMMUNITY RIGHT TO KNOW ACT

The manufacturer or supplier of chemical substances or mixtures shall label then in accordance with NJ Worker and Community Right to Know Law (NJSA 35:51 et seq., and NJAC 5:89-5 et seq.,). Containers that the law and rules require to be labeled shall show the Chemical Abstracts Service number of all the components and the chemical name. Further, all applicable Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) – hazardous substance fact sheet – must be furnished.

56. Bidder should be aware of the following statutes that represent "Truth in Contracting" laws:

- NJSA 2C:21-34, et seq. governs false claims and representations by bidders. It is a serious crime for the bidder to knowingly submit a false claim and/or knowingly make material misrepresentation.
- NJSA 2C:27-10 provides that a person commits a crime if said person offers a benefit to a public servant for an official act performed or to be performed by a public servant, which is a violation of official duty.
- NJSA 2C:27-11 provides that a bidder commits a crime if said person, directly or indirectly, confers or agrees to confer any benefit not allowed by law to a public servant.
- Bidder should consult the statues or legal counsel for further information.

57. When a business entity has received \$50,000.00 or more in public contracts from public entities, the business entity shall file a report with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC). www.elec.state.nj.us is the ELEC website.

58. CONFLICT OF INTEREST AND NON-COLLUSION

Each bidder must execute and submit as part of the Bid Proposal a "Non-Collusion Affidavit" which at the minimum shall attest that:

- A. The bidder has not entered into any agreement or participated in any collusion with any other person, corporate entity or government entity, or competitive bidding either alone or with any other person, corporate entity or government entity in connection with the above named project;




