#18-215 Proposing Ridgewood to Establish Committee to Water Rates

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Village of Ridgewood establishes water rate increases with the adoption of a majority vote of its members present for Ridgewood Water Company; and,

WHEREAS, the water rate payers of Wyckoff, Midland Park and Glen Rock have no representation on the governing body of the Village of Ridgewood and the governing body of Ridgewood is not accountable to the water rate payers of Glen Rock, Midland Park and Wyckoff; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Village of Ridgewood does not view their role as fiduciary to the water rate payers who do not elect them but who suffer the consequence of their actions; and,

WHEREAS, on 6/27/18 the governing body of the Village of Ridgewood adopted Ordinance #3636 (which re-established water rates and fees from 2010-2017) and Ordinance #3637 which amended water rates and fees for 2018 of Ridgewood Water Company by a vote of four (4) votes, with one member absent from the vote; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff recommends that the governing body of the Village of Ridgewood establish a committee of two representatives each from Ridgewood, Glen Rock, Midland Park and Wyckoff for the purpose of investigating and establishing a Municipal Utilities Authority to review, recommend, and approve any future rate increases and fee increases as a process to be inclusive, fair and to demonstrate a fiduciary responsibility to the water rate payers of Glen Rock, Midland Park and Wyckoff for Ridgewood Water Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that the Township Committee recommends that the Village of Ridgewood Governing Body establish a committee of two representatives each from Ridgewood, Glen Rock, Midland Park and Wyckoff for the purpose of investigating establishing a Municipal Utilities Authority to review, recommend, and approve any future rate increases and fee increases as a process to be inclusive, fair, transparent and to demonstrate a fiduciary responsibility to the water rate payers of Glen Rock, Midland Park and Wyckoff for Ridgewood Water Company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipal Clerk forward certified copies of this resolution to the Mayors, Governing Body Members and Municipal Administrators of Midland Park, Glen Rock and Ridgewood, District 38 and 40 Legislators and the New Jersey Board of Public Utility Members.

#18-216 Authorize Road Closure for Lafayette Avenue

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff is the recipient of a New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) trust fund grant after a competitive application process to improve Lafayette Avenue this summer; and,

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE XII "SCHEDULES" IN CHAPTER 177 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A NEW SECTION, "177-52.2-SCHEDULE V: RIGHT TURN PROHIBITIONS FOR VEHICLES OF CERTAIN WEIGHT OR GREATER"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, that Section 177-52.2, schedule V: Right turn prohibition for vehicles of certain weight or greater" is hereby established.

SECTION 1

Section 177-52.2-Schedule V: Right turn prohibitions for vehicles of certain weight or greater.

<u>Trucks with a vehicle weight of 10 tons or greater when traveling on</u> <u>Wyckoff Avenue in the southbound direction are prohibited from making a</u> <u>right turn to travel westbound on Franklin Avenue.</u>

SECTION 2 - Except as hereby modified all other sections of Article XII, Schedules, in Chapters 177-33 – through Chapters 177-52.1 shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 3 -</u> This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication accord.

ORDINANCE #1859

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE XIV "SPECIAL PERMIT PARKING" IN CHAPTER 177 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING FEES AND ESTABLISHING A HANDICAPPED PARKING FEE IN THE COMMUTER PARKING PERMIT FEES IN SECTIONS 177-54, "CORNERSTONE CHURCH PARKING LOT" AND IN SECTION 177-54.1 "WYCKOFF COMMUNITY PARK PARKING LOT".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Sections 177-54, "Cornerstone Church Parking Lot", and 177-54.1, "Wyckoff Community Park Parking Lot" are hereby amended to reads as follows:

SECTION 1

Section 177-54 D. Application for permit; fees; issuance of permits.

D. Application for permit; fees; issuance of permits.

(1) Annual applications for permits shall be made on forms furnished by the Township Clerk's Office and shall be available at the Township Clerk's office.

(2) Fee for parking permit and replacement permit.

(a) The fee for a parking permit for a licensing year, for resident of the Township of Wyckoff shall be $\frac{126.00}{310.00}$, and for nonresidents, $\frac{303.00}{310.00}$.

(b) The fee for a replacement parking permit for a licensing year for residents and nonresidents is \$25.00.

(c) The fee for a parking permit for the period of May 15th through September 15th of a licensing year, for residents of the Township of Wyckoff shall be $\frac{60.00 \pm 61.00}{51.00}$; and for non-residents; $\frac{80.00 \pm 82.00}{50.00}$.

(d) The fee for a handicap parking permit for a licensing year, for a resident of the Township of Wyckoff shall be \$110.00 and for non-residents, \$290.00.

(3) A parking permit may be displayed on family-owned or leased vehicles only and is not transferable.

(4) The number of parking permits to be issued for any licensing year

shall be determined by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff.

(5) All fees shall not be proratable for the period between the date of issuance of the permit and the end of the licensing year. The licensing year shall commence on the first day of January and end on the 31^{st} day of December.

SECTION 2

Section 177-54.1 D. Application for permit; fees; issuance of permits.

- (1) Annual applications for permits shall be made on forms furnished by the Township Clerk's office and shall be available at the Township Clerk's office.
- (2) Fee for parking permit and replacement permit.

(a) The fee for a parking permit for a licensing year, for resident of the Township of Wyckoff shall be $\frac{\$126.00}{\$130.00}$, and for nonresidents, $\frac{\$303.00}{\$310.00}$.

(b) The fee for a replacement parking permit for a licensing year for residents and nonresidents is \$25.00.

(c) The fee for a parking permit for the period of May 15th through September 15th of a licensing year for residents shall be $\frac{60.00 \text{ } 61.00}{61.00}$; and non-residents; $\frac{80.00 \text{ } 82.00}{82.00}$.

(d) The fee for a handicap permit for a licensing year, for a resident of the Township of Wyckoff shall be \$110.00 and for a non-resident, \$290.00.

(3) A parking permit may be displayed on family-owned or leased vehicles only and is not transferable.

(4) The number of parking permits to be issued for any licensing year shall be determined by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff.

(5) All fees shall not be proratable for the period between the date of issuance of the permit and the end of the licensing year. The licensing year shall commence on the first day of January and end on the 31st day of December.

<u>SECTION 3 –</u> Except as hereby amended, all other sections of Article XIV, special permit parking in Chapter 177 of The Code of the Township of Wyckoff remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 4 –</u> This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF ORDINANCE #1860

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 186, "ZONING," SECTION 186-22, "REGULATIONS APPLYING TO ALL ZONES," OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF MARIJUANA WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Legislature is considering the legalization and/or decriminalization of the distribution, sale and/or consumption of marijuana within the State; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff considers the sale of marijuana within the Township to be detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare, and inimical to the current zoning of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee desires to amend the Township of Wyckoff Land Development Code so as to provide a safe environment for all of the citizens of Wyckoff in response to the State Legislature potentially legalizing the use and sale of marijuana in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Wyckoff has determined that the sale and distribution of marijuana presents special concerns of safety, security and general nuisances that arise as the result of the use of drugs and substances that can affect the youth of the Township and others; and

WHEREAS, given the current Comprehensive Master Plan of the Township of Wyckoff and the Development Ordinances implementing that plan there are no areas where the sale of and distribution of recreational marijuana can be safely established given the overwhelming security and safety concerns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 186, entitled "Zoning," Section 186-22, "Regulations applying to all zones," shall be amended to add new subparagraph W., prohibiting the sale of marijuana and marijuana paraphernalia, as follows:

Section 186-22. Regulations applying to all zones.

W. The sale of marijuana and paraphernalia including but not limited to equipment and/or devices associated with marijuana use is hereby prohibited in all zoning districts, except medical marijuana prescribed by a physician and dispensed by a licensed pharmacist.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflict.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, part of any section or clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff declares that it would have passed the ordinance and each section thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately

upon passage and publication according to law.

Ordinance #1860 Discussion

Committeewoman Rubenstein said, with reference to Ordinance #1860, that she read on Wyckoff Moms blog site a reference to the direct sale of CBD (Cannabidiol). A discussion ensued, and the Township Attorney was asked to research if CBD is the drug component of marijuana and other products or unregulated products associated with the sale of marijuana.
